Dr. Steven Black is the owner of Plastic Surgical Center, located in Omaha, Nebraska focusing on a tradition of personalized care, specializing in the individual needs of his clients. Dr. Black has been published in the Infection Control and Hospital Epidemiology; Ostomy/ Wound Management; and Nursing Clinics of North America; Journal of Surgical Oncology; and the Nebraska Medical Journal.

Dr. Black graduated from the University of Nebraska, College of Medicine in 1972 with a Doctor of Medicine. Following the completion of a Rotating Surgery internship at the Mayo Graduate School of Medicine, Mayo Clinic, Rochester, Minnesota in 1973, he completed his residency in General Surgery at the Mayo Clinic in 1977 and in Plastic Surgery at Mayo Clinic in 1979.
